In an effort to keep our prices as low as possible, we have implemented a non-cash adjustment fee. The NCA program was part of the Durbin Amendment passed by Congress to help SMB deal with the rising cost of processing credit cards and the rewards programs associated with them.

Our standard pricing now incorporates a non-cash adjustment fee (3.5%) applied by the Point-of-Sale System

We further provide a Cash Discount from the regular NCA price in accordance with section (4)(c)(4) of the same document.
